

Data Protection Policy

The Hebridean Sheep Society collects and uses personal information about its members and supporters. This information is gathered to enable the Society to provide its members and supporters with membership and registration services.

How we use this information

- The Society only processes information necessary to establish or maintain membership or support
- The Society only processes information necessary to provide or administer activities for people who are members of the Society or have regular contact with it
- The Society only shares the information with people and organisations necessary to carry out the Society's activities, and only when the data subject (information owner) has given consent
- The Society only keeps the information while the individual is a member or supporter or as long as necessary for member/supporter administration.
