Awards Policy

In order to recognise the contribution to the survival and growth of the Hebridean Sheep Breed made by long-standing flocks, the Society awards a certificate to flock owners who have maintained their flocks and registered sheep with the Society for 26 years. The list of members receiving the award each year is read at the AGM and recorded in the minutes, and published in *The Black Sheep*.

In order to recognise activity which has significantly contributed to the success of the Hebridean Sheep Breed and the HSS, the Society awards an engraved quaich to members who have made an outstanding contribution to the breed and the HSS over an extended period. Nominations may be made by other members, with supporting evidence, and adjudged by the Board of Trustees. The Board will inform the nominator(s) of unsuccessful bids, with reasons.
