AUCTIONEER'S TERMS & CONDITIONS OF SALE
(Incorporating the Auctioneer's Terms and Conditions)

1. The biddings to be regulated by the Auctioneers and the highest bidder, subject to the Vendor's reserve (if any), will be the purchaser. No bid shall be retracted and if any dispute should arise between two or more bidders, the lot in dispute to be put up again and resold, or the Auctioneers may determine the dispute at their own discretion and their decision shall be final. The Auctioneers reserve the right to refuse the bid of any person without being called upon to give reason for such action.
2. The Purchaser to give his full name and dwelling place and pay for all Lots purchased immediately at the close of sale. No Lot or Lots shall be removed from the sale premises until paid for and a pass-out slip obtained from the Auctioneer's office but each and every Lot shall immediately at the fall of the hammer be considered as delivered and be and remain in every respect at the absolute risk and expense of the respective purchaser or purchasers thereof and shall be removed from the sale premises at the purchaser's expense. The right of property shall not pass until the full purchase price is paid.
3. Purchasers paying by cheque must be prepared, if required, to produce a banker's reference. As a result of the Money Laundering Regulations (2003) the auctioneers are unable to accept cash payments in excess of nine thousand pounds sterling for any single or linked purchase transaction.
4. All statements in the catalogue or made by the Auctioneers at the time of sale, also the correct identification of the animals, are the entire responsibility of the Vendors. The Auctioneers take no personal responsibility for the correctness of such statements or identities.
5. All statements in the catalogue, or any made by the Auctioneers at the time of sale relating to any veterinary or other tests are to be taken as statements of fact only. No such statements shall guarantee the purchaser of any animal against loss arising from the subsequent reaction of such animal to any test administered after the sale and the Vendors shall not be liable in any way should this occur.
6. All stock is sold subject to the Conditions of Sale recommended for use at markets by the Livestock Auctioneers' Markets Committee for England and Wales except in so far as these conflict with any Special Conditions applicable to the sale of pedigree stock, when the latter Conditions shall prevail.
7. Neither the Vendors nor the Auctioneers will be responsible for any accident or injury to persons or property, through fire or any other cause whatsoever, nor for any damage by animals prior to, during or after the sale.
8. No undertaking by the Auctioneers or their servants to take charge of any Lot or Lots after the sale or to forward them to their destination shall be held to impose upon the Auctioneers any legal obligation or vitiate any of these Conditions.
9. In as much as the Auctioneers act as agents for a disclosed principal they shall not be considered personally responsible for any default on the part of either purchasers or Vendors and the remedy shall be against them only and not against the Auctioneers.
10. If these conditions are unfulfilled, the Vendors or Auctioneers shall have the power to resell the Lots, retaining any surplus and charging any deficiency and expense to the defaulter.

COMMISSION & BUYERS PREMIUM: All Livestock will be sold in guineas (105 pence). **Commission and buyer's premium will be charged at 5%+VAT on all Livestock.**

RESERVE PRICES: Any reserve prices must be submitted to the Auctioneers Office in writing on sale day prior to the sale of any lot. It may be handed to the auctioneer in writing as you sell your stock but cannot be given verbally.

BREED SOCIETY EVENT: This is an official sale for all the participating breeds which are responsible for any inspections, card grading and showing for their breed. Each Society will provide their own stewards, inspectors, judges, cards, rosettes and trophies where applicable. See breed sections for contact addresses and society details.

DISCLAIMER: The participating Breed Societies, their representatives, judges, inspectors & stewards, Melton Mowbray Market and the steering committee are acting in good faith on behalf of participating vendors, and accept no responsibility or liability for any death, accident or injury to people, animals or property at the event. Vendors and purchasers are responsible for their animals at all times.

CATALOGUE: The catalogue has been prepared in good faith from the information supplied by vendors & breed societies. Grassroots Systems Ltd, Melton Mowbray Market Auctioneers and the Breed Societies are not responsible for its accuracy. It is the responsibility of the vendor to ensure it is correct and that any anomalies or errors are announced before the sale of any lots.

PARTICIPATING BREEDS: Entries have only been accepted from members of participating Breed Societies and for animals registered or eligible for registration in their flock books.

ORDER OF SALE: Strictly in catalogue order with the exception of Breed champions in some breeds. Please see Breed Society details. Please note sales are conducted simultaneously.

SOCIETY TRANSFER FEES AND LEVIES: Societies transfer fees and sale levies will be deducted at the usual rate. Please consult your respective breed society.

CATTLE & PIGS: Please see separate catalogue or contact the Market Office on 01664 562971

STATUTORY REGULATIONS: The event will be carried out in full compliance with the DEFRA and other statutory regulations.

IDENTIFICATION: All entries must be tagged in accordance with current DEFRA regulations. Tag numbers must correspond with numbers on pedigree certificates and in the catalogue. Any animal whose ear tag does not match that printed in the catalogue will be rejected from the event.

RETAGS: Must be reported to the Auctioneers Office.

SUBSTITUTES: Any that do occur by special arrangement **MUST** be reported to the auctioneers, so that the correct animals are transferred and recorded in the market movement records.

NUMBERING: Vendors will be provided with lot number neck tags on arrival. Please ensure these are put onto the correct sheep on arrival. The neck tags will be collected from the vendors as the sheep leave.

WEANING: All lots must have been weaned at least 2 weeks prior to the event and in the case of suckling ewes, must have been properly dried off.

PENNING: All animals must be penned in the space allocated. Vendors are always solely responsible for and in charge of their stock whilst on the premises.

MV ACCREDITED & SCRAPIE MONITORED: Provision will be made for MV Accredited and scrapie monitored sheep which will be sold at the start of the sale. Vendors should ensure all the relevant certification is brought on the day. It is the responsibility of the owner to ensure they follow the plans laid out in the market to safeguard the status of their livestock, which remains their responsibility at all times. Hands should be washed prior to entering the Heath Scheme areas.

SELLING ORDER: Females will be sold in their pens 'off the boards' and may be offered in groups or as individuals. Rams will be sold individually in pens in catalogue order. Vendors are encouraged to consider selling females in pairs or small matched groups.

HEALTH SCHEME SELLING ORDER: Because of the restrictions imposed by the regulations concerning Health Scheme Flocks, it has been necessary to pen and sell animals in these high health categories together. We have tried to make the catalogue as clear as possible and have included a plan.

ANIMAL HEALTH: Vendors will be expected to ensure that their animals are in good health and, to the best of their knowledge free from infectious or contagious disease. The entry form includes a signed declaration to this effect and entry to the sale therefore carries a warranty of soundness from the vendor. In the case of sheep this includes a warranty in respect of mouth, udder, testicles and that female sheep over 2 years have bred a lamb.

BREED INSPECTION: Some Breed Societies will carry out breed inspections, please see each breed section for details. Breed Society inspections do not constitute any form of guarantee or warranty. Purchasers should inspect animals themselves to ensure they are suitable, prior to purchase.

STOCK REJECTED ON WELFARE GROUNDS: A quarantine area will be made available but rejected stock should be removed from the market as soon as possible.

TRANSPORTATION: All livestock must be transported in vehicles or trailers which comply with the law. There will be washing out facilities at the market and will be open from 8.00am-5pm on Friday and Saturday. All livestock must travel with the correct licenses. If in doubt, please contact an Animal Health Officer at your local DEFRA offices.

ANIMAL TRANSIT: Animals in transit and not entered into the event, will be strictly prohibited. Swapping animals in the car park is STRICTLY PROHIBITED and is ILLEGAL.

HAY & STRAW: A limited amount of straw will be provided. Vendors must supply their own hay, additional straw and buckets.

ORDER OF SALE: Animals will be sold strictly in catalogue order in breed sections with all sheep being sold off the boards. Auctioneers will be selling simultaneously. It is the responsibility of the vendor to ensure their animals are presented for sale at the correct time. Rams will be sold individually in pens as per catalogue.

DOGS: Dogs will not be permitted in the livestock areas.

Sale Warranties – Re: Bluetongue

Announcements will be made pre-sale, that all animals are sold as having no known “clinical signs of Bluetongue” at the time of sale. However, no warranties are given post sale.

It is the responsibility of prospective purchasers to inspect the animals before purchase, to satisfy themselves that the animals they intend to purchase have no clinical signs of Bluetongue infection.

All Animals are sold “as seen”, with no warranties given for the presence of Bluetongue infection following the fall of the hammer (“contract for Sale”)

The only protection against Bluetongue is vaccination – the LAA strongly recommends that members encourage their customers to vaccinate their stock to protect them.

Reserves and Minimum Upsets Notes for Buyers and Seller:

A Minimum Upset - is the minimum price, set by the Breed Societies, below which animals cannot be sold.

If your breed has a Minimum Upset, it will be published at the beginning of the breed section.

Reserve Prices - All vendors are entitled to place a reserve on their animals. A reserve is the price below which the seller is not prepared to sell.

The Reserve acts like a bid, so the auctioneers can 'run' a single bidder up to that reserve price.

Auctioneers cannot 'run' a single bidder if there is no reserve.

How to place a reserve - Sellers should place the reserve with the auctioneers before the sale. Clearly write the lot number and the price in Guineas (£1.05), below which you will not sell, and hand it to the auctioneer before they start selling your sheep. The sale will be noisy so do not attempt to give verbal instructions.

Groups - Groups of ewes are sold at a price per sheep, regardless of the size of the group.

Private Sales – If your sheep does not sell under the hammer, but someone offers to buy it after the sale, you are permitted to do this. However, you MUST put the sale through the auctioneer's office. Animal movement records to and from markets are strictly controlled and monitored. It also means that the market collects the funds and passes them to you safely. Animals sold in this way are not included in the breed averages and are not subject to Minimum Upset price.

BIOSECURITY NOTICE:

Please read and observe the following:

Excessive dirty vehicles will not be allowed entry, therefore ensure vehicle is clean before arrival. All vehicles transporting livestock will be subject to a documentation check before entry to market site.

All visitors and traders must ensure they wear clean clothing and footwear before entering the market site.

All visitors and traders using car park areas please use main entrance.

Hauliers and farmers delivering livestock must disinfect their boots before and after loading or unloading.

Livestock purchased or unsold will not be allowed to move unless an authorised "pass slip" has been issued by the main office

No livestock will be allowed to remain on the premises after a sale.

Only staff, livestock hauliers, owners or their agents are permitted to load or unload livestock.

Wash hands thoroughly when leaving pen areas. Please observe our staff's instructions at all times.

Our on site Biosecurity Officer will only be too pleased to give you assistance.
